Keep in Mind

Using VR at an event

- I usually ask for a little more space than a 10x10 if possible because people congregate while waiting.
- Videos are long, but people want to watch the entire thing.
- At events, crowd control is one of the most stressful things – who's next?
- Keeping units charged up is the next toughest thing. Try to plug them in between views if possible.
- Explain to parents or teachers that the kids are watching a video. Parents get impatient if they think the kids are just playing.
