

The 2020 4-H Virtual Dairy Quizbowl Contest will be held on June 30, 2020. The contest will be hosted by NCSU, using Quizbowl Systems Pro. Because the contest will be virtual this year, some details of the contest will be different. Please read all the information below regarding format and equipment needed to participate in the contest.

Important Contest Details:

- 1. Only senior teams will be allowed to compete.** Each school/county/club can enter up to two teams. Teams should be registered [here](#) by June 10, 2020.
- 2. The contest will be administered using Quizbowl System Pro and Zoom. Students will need access to a smart phone and a computer to participate in the contest.**
- 3. A Q&A session for registered coaches/agents will be held prior to the contest.**

Contest Format and Other Details:

This contest is designed for youth to participate from any location. Youth may participate from the comfort and safety of their own home or any other location of their choosing. Youth will need access to the internet, a computer for Zoom application, and a smart phone (which serves as a remote buzzer).

Participants will need to download the Quizbowl System Pro player app to a smart phone, from the app store. You can find the app by searching "QuizBowl Systems Player App" in the iOS or Android device store site.

Despite being virtual, much of the contest will be similar to a traditional quizbowl contest. Teams will answer 5 questions (Phase A) followed by a toss up round of 20 questions (Phase B). Individuals will take a short seating exam to determine order of play. This exam will also be administered online and will be sent to participants prior to the contest start.

Youth will join a Zoom session, from a link that will be sent the day of the contest. After completing Phase A, two teams will be joined together to complete Phase B. A moderator will read the questions, a judge will be present to answer any questions or concerns, and a time/score keeper will also be present in the room. Timing, points, and other details will remain as outlined in the current [NC Dairy Youth Quizbowl Rules](#). Winning teams will proceed to the next round and will receive a new Zoom link to join.
